Agenda 1: Administrative and Financial approval of ULMMC Projects

It was brought to the notice of all the members about the approval of Rs 24.41 Crores under SDRF, Capacity Building by SEC for the landslide related projects and for establishment of laboratory under ULMMC as per the Table below:

The Executive Committee approved the project works/costs and authorized the Director General, ULMMC to execute and permit the variation in estimated cost as per the govt. rules.

Agenda 2: Modification of Recruitment Framework

2a: Modification in Essential & Desirable Qualifications/Age/ Salary/Experience

It was brought to kind notice of all the members that the approved vacancies under ULMMC are 75 including three posts of Director General, Additional Director General and Finance Controller. Out of total seventy-five posts, 50 posts would be recruited in the first phase as per



office order no 205/XVIII-B-2/22-05(UDRP-AF)/2021. At present, 29 posts have been recruited and the other posts were advertised but could not be recruited due to non-availability of suitable candidates. Therefore, modification is required in recruitment framework and Executive Committee approved the following modifications (as underlined& bold) in the table below:

2b: Modification in Tenure:

It was brought into notice of all the committee members that tenure of all the contractual posts under ULMMC is of one year. Because of less duration of tenure, promising and experienced applicants are not willing to apply. Therefore, it was proposed to have the minimum three years of tenure for each post and the committee approved the same.

It was also approved that the contract of earlier employees, who have completed one year will be modified accordingly and new contract tenure will be implemented for the remaining term.

Agenda 3: Consultancy Charges for DPR and Project Monitoring

3a: Consultancy Charges-The consultancy charges for investigations and DPR work are proposed as under which wasapproved by Executive Committee.

3b: Consultancy Services: The Chairperson directed to Director, ULMMC to undertake consultancy work from Government and Private agencies to establish ULMMC as self-sustainable and allowed to participate in Tender/Bids/RFP/EoI invited by other agencies. It was also suggested by the members that it should be made mandatory to carry out geological / geotechnical investigations before construction of any large building in the hilly terrain and for that ULMMC may be consulted.

Agenda 4: Increment Policy and Other Benefits

The Increment Policy and other benefits related to annual increment, TA/DA and group insurance for the ULMMC Staff was discussed in the Committee.

4a: Increment Policy: The Executive Committee approved to follow the increment policy as per UDRP/U-PREPARE (World Bank aided projects) under Dept. of Disaster Management and as per office order no 154649/XVIII-(B-2)/23/20(UDRP-AF)2023 dated 18th September 2023. This has already approved from Finance Department as per order no 154288/2023 dated 14.09.2023 in which increment for different salary scale is as below:

After due deliberations the committee directed the following-

- A new rationalize salary structure should be framed to commersurate with increment policy.
 - ii. A minimum & maximum salary range for each class of employees/designations linked with number of years of relevant work experience.
- iii. Fix relevant work experience (in years) commensurate with the salary.

A complete policy including all the above points must be prepare and put up for necessary approval.

4c: Proposal for TA/DA:

Presently, DA for the official tours is paid as per Govt order no (Finance department) 18/XXVII (7)/18-50(14)/2017 dated 23 Jan 2019. As per the inflation rate, it was hard to cope up with the current TA/DA rate by the field staff. The matter was discussed in detail and committee directed to prepare a new proposal with respect to the inflation index and duly approve it from Finance Department.

On the issues related to accommodation, it was appraised to the committee members that ULMMC staff often have accommodation related issues as per the Uttarakhand Government approved rates that are too low to provide logistics. Therefore, it was proposed for prebooking of hotels/ guest houses before commencement of field and reimbursement of the amount will be as per actual expenditure basis/original bills and the committee approved the same. It was directed to frame a proposal to fix upper limit for different level officials of ULMMC within state of Uttarakhand and outside stay. It was further specified that Central Government Rules may also be referred in case of stay at outside of state.

4d: Group Insurance: Since, most of the employees of ULMMC visit field frequently and worked in tough terrain, therefore it was proposed to have group insurance both accidental and death for the field staff and the members agreed for the same.

Agenda 5: Modification in By laws

It was brought to kind notice of all the Executive Committee members about the use of terminology which has not mentioned under the approved structure of ULMMC. Therefore, in order to correct the same and to avoid any confusion, following amendment are proposed in Bylaws. Following are points to be amended (as summarize below) while rest of By-laws document shall remain unchanged-

- 1. Instead of terminology "Chief Executive Officer/CEO" and "Additional Chief Executive Officer /ACEO", the "Director General/DIRECTOR GENERAL" and "Additional Director General/ ADIRECTOR GENERAL" are proposed to use respectively in the modified Bylaws
- 2. Since, the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson for the Executive as well as Governing Body are same i.e. the Chief Secretary, GoUK and Secretary, Disaster Management, GoUK, therefore it was proposed that Chairperson of Executive Committee will become the Principal Secretary/

Secretary, Disaster Management and Vice Chairperson will be "Nil" for Executive Committee. Rest of the board members remain same.

Provided that, such co-option for a period exceeding one year shall have to be ratified ex post facto by the General Body. But such considerations shall be limited in rare cases only.

During the presentation committee has issued following directions-

- Amendment in Bylaws of ULMMC viz- Designations, Definition of Designations, Chairperson of Executive Committee, provision for post facto approval etc. presented before the committee. Further, it was also informed that the same has already been reviewed by the Department of Law, GoUK and advised to proceed with proposed changes through concerned Administrative Department.
- The committee directed, to replace the term "General Body" with "Governing Body" in Byelaws of ULMMC.
- The committee approved the proposed amendments in the Bylaws of ULMMC. Details of amendments is enclosed.

Additional Agenda

The additional agenda discussed with due permission of Chairperson are as follow:

- 1. Meeting with Stake holders: The Secretary, Disaster Management brought to the notice of committee members about the wrong practices of vertical cutting for construction of commercial/large buildings on steep slopes that aggravated the instability. After due deliberation and discussion on the issue, it was directed by the Chairperson to call a meeting with all stake holders line department & development authorities to put a cap on hill cutting and mandatory investigation before construction of large building in hilly terrain, so that appropriate action should be taken by respective departments.
- Publications and common platform for data sharing: It was directed by the Chairperson to publish work done by ULMMC and create a Research-wing. It was also suggested to maintain the publications and reports in digital form which should provide easy access to line departments and avoid duplicity of work.
- 3. *Internship Programs:* The Executive Committee directed to Director, ULMMC to frame a policy related with internship program for inducting Intern/Young professionals in order to promote innovative ideas, and get it approved in next EC meeting.
- 4. Requirement of addition field staff: It was suggested by committee to take permission from Finance Department to recruit additional field staff if ULMMC gets Project



Management Consultancy for landslide mitigation projects and require field staff beyond the approved staff strength.

 Clearance from Forest Department: It was suggested by the Committee to immediatelystart the process of getting clearance from Forest Department in regard to landslide mitigation projects in reserved forest areas like in Naina peak, Nainital and Mansa Devi, Haridwar.

The meeting ended with thanks to the Chairperson.
